



#485 CHRYSANTHEMUM HAT

DESIGNED BY KIRSTEN HIPSKY



Finished measurements:

20" around and 8" tall

Yarn:

2 skeins [Valley Yarns Stockbridge](#) (50% Superfine Alpaca/50% Wool, 50g/109yd) color Kiwi

Needles:

US size 7 (4.5mm) 16" circular needles or size needed to get gauge

Other Materials:

4 stitch markers.

Gauge:

4.5 sts and 8 rows = 1" in Stockinette Stitch

A super simple, bright and stretchy beanie knit in the round from the brim up with a ribbed welt stitch pattern.

Abbreviations:

k: knit; p: purl; ssk: slip two sts as if to knit, put tip of left needle up into both sts and knit them together;
st(s): stitch(es)

Directions:

Cast on 88 sts and join in the round, placing marker to note the beginning of round.

Rnds 1-4: *K1, p1; repeat from *.

Rnds 5-10: Knit.

Repeat rnds 1-10 three more times, or until hat measures 3" shorter than desired length, then work rnds 1-4 once more.

Next round: *K2, place marker; repeat from *. 4 markers placed.

Decrease round: *Ssk, k to marker, slip marker; repeat from *. 4 sts decreased

Repeat this decrease round every round until 8 sts remain.

Cut yarn and draw through remaining stitches.

Sew in all loose ends.
