



# Ziggity-Zag Blanket

a snuggly, striped chevron blanket

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**Yarn:** Wonderland Yarns “So Fond of Rainbows” Enchanted Woodland in “March Hare” worsted weight yarn: 20, 1 oz skeins: 100% superwash merino: 920 total yards (alternately choose 4 of your favorite Mini Skein Packs)

**Needles & Notions:** US size 10 circular needles, minimum of 24” long (or size to obtain gauge)

**Gauge:** 13.5 sts & 20 rows = 4 inches (gauge can be approximate, but may effect your overall size)

**Measurements:** 37” wide and 48” long, blocked

**Abbreviations:** **K:** knit, **P:** purl, **K2tog:** knit two together; **CDD:** slip 2 sts together as if to knit two together, knit one, pssso; **SSK:** slip, slip, knit; **CO:** cast on; **BO:** bind off, **M1R & M1L:** make one right & make one left

**Notes:** You may use the colors in any way you like—in order as a rainbow, or mixed-up for a stripe effect. For our sample, we used them from one end of the collection to the other.

With your first color, cast on 125 sts.

Knit 4 rows, then begin working pattern below:

**Row 1 (RS) and all right side rows:** k3, ssk, k7, m1R, \*k1, m1L, k8, CDD, k8, m1R\* repeat until 13 sts remain, k1, m1L, k7, k2tog, k3.

**Row 2 (WS) and all wrong side rows:** k3, purl to last 3 sts, k3.

Work in pattern for a total of 4 rows (2 repeats), then switch to the next color.

Continue repeating row 1 and 2, working 10 rows (5 repeats) with each color, until you reach your last mini skein.

With your final color, work 4 rows in pattern (2 repeats), work row 1 once more and finish with garter stitch by knitting 4 rows and binding off on a WS row, knitwise.

Weave in ends.
